



Minor Sections

- Page #1 of your paper
- Running head at the top of the page
 - Running head is in ALL CAPITAL LETTERS
 - This running head should also be included in the header of your paper, along with page #'s
- Title
- Name
- Affiliation
 - Eastern Kentucky University

- Page #2 of your paper
 - w/ Abstract heading
- 120 words MAXIMUM
- One paragraph summary of:
 - Hypotheses
 - Method
 - Results
 - Implications (if you have space)
- Good exercise for writing concisely




- After your Discussion section, before your Tables and Figures
- Alphabetical by first author
- See APA Manual for how to format references from sources other than journals and edited book chapters



Journal Article Reference

- Author names
- Date of publication
- Title of article
- Name of journal, volume # (*both in italics*)
- Page numbers
- Gore, J.S., & Gore, T.M. (2005). Writing a paper. *Journal of Writing*, 3, 45-50.



Edited Book Chapter Reference

- Author names, date of publication, title of chapter
- Names of Editors (w/ "Eds." in parentheses)
- Book title, Volume # (*in italics*)
- Page numbers (in parentheses w/ "pp.")
- Publisher location: publisher name
